Worship service follows at 11:00am.

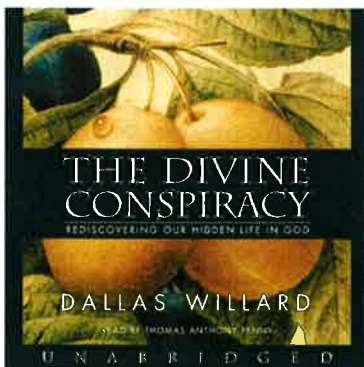
The Divine Conspiracy

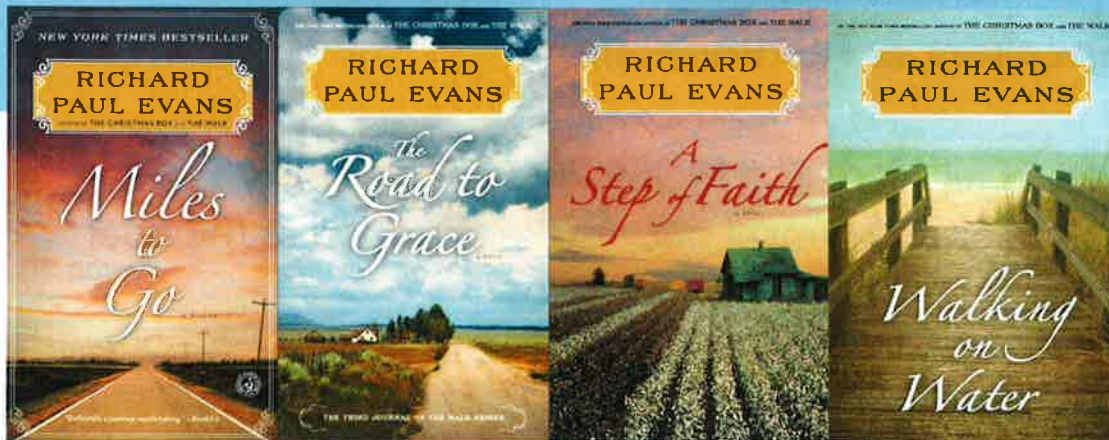
